## Baltimore Center Stage Announces Broadway's Syndee Winters in a Special Concert Performance

Baltimore, MD January 4, 2019---- Baltimore Center Stage is thrilled to announce Grammy-nominated Broadway actress Syndee Winters will be in concert on Saturday February 9, 2019 in the Pearlstone Theater for a one-night-only special performance of her album



Syndee Winters: Lessons From a Lady, a musical love letter to American icon Lena Horne. Thanking her for her journey and sacrifice in her professional and personal life, Winters weaves stories and highlights the parallels of the life of Ms. Horne with those of her own professional and personal journey while infusing a beautiful interpretation of the standards Horne made famous, including "Yesterday, When I Was Young," and the iconic song from the 1970's film *The Wiz*, "Believe in Yourself."

Known for her incredible turns on Broadway, including roles in *Hamilton* and *Motown the Musical*, Winters has recently reprised her role as Nala in *The Lion King* on Broadway. She is nominated for a Grammy for her performance in NBC's *Jesus Christ Superstar* with John Legend. Like Horne, Winters considers herself both a storyteller and a songstress. She spent years researching and discovering Horne's lifelong work as a performer and activist. "I want people to know who she was, and how much work she put in so that space could exist for artists like myself, like Halle Berry, Diana Ross and so many others," Winters said. "She is very important, and so is her story." Winters was last at Baltimore Center Stage when she performed at the theater's 2017 benefit Gala.

"From the moment I met Syndee I fell in love with her, her spectacular voice, and her artistry, said Baltimore Center Stage Executive Director Michael Ross. "What a great Valentine to have her back on our Pearlstone stage." Later in February, Baltimore Center Stage will also host a workshop of Winters' one woman show *Lena: A Moment With a Lady*.
